RESOLUTION CHO 06-002

A RESOLUTION TO AFFIRM THE ONGOING USE OF THE NAME CHOCTAW
AND RELATED SYMBOLS BY MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE

WHEREAS, Mississippi College is located in what was called the Choctaw territory, and the old Indian trail that became the Natchez Trace passed through the campus, and

WHEREAS, in 1920 the Mississippi College student body voted overwhelmingly to affix the name *Choctaw* to its athletic teams, and

WHEREAS, the Mississippi College Board of Trustees, in its resolution of 1920, affirmed the use of the name *Choctaw* to its athletic teams, and

convened and held this 11th day of October 2005; and that the foregoing Resolution was duly adopted by a vote of 11 members in favor, 3 opposed and 0 abstaining.
